

ReadMe for GedStar V5.2

Please read this document before installing GedStar 5.2

Requirements

- A PC running Windows 98/98SE/ME/NT/2000/XP. Specifically, Windows 95 is no longer a supported platform.
- A handheld device running PalmOS V3.0 or later. This covers everything except the old, original “Palm Pilot” devices. Support for PalmOS 2.0 has now been discontinued.

Installation

- If you are using the *conduit* feature, deactivate it before proceeding with the installation.
- Uninstall any previous versions of GedStar from your PC before installing this version. This is important in order to prevent confusion with prior versions.
- You do *not* need to uninstall GedStar from your handheld.
- Run the self-extracting install program.

New Features

- Supports hi-res 320x320 screens and the expanded 320x480 screen mode on various models of Tungsten, Clie, and Garmin iQue.

Known Limitations

- The relationship calculator only finds one relationship. However, it should find the *closest* relationship.

Five-Way Navigation Control and Jog-Dial

The support for the 5-way navigation control on the Tungsten-T follows Palm’s operation recommendations as closely as possible considering that GedStar is somewhat different from a standard Palm application. As in the standard Palm applications, the buttons do different things depending on whether you are in the **standard** mode or in the **select** mode. For Sony CLIEs with the Jog Dial, moving the dial up and down is equivalent to nav **Up** and **Down**; pushing the dial is the same as **Select**, and the back button is the same as **Left**. There is no Jog Dial equivalent to **Right**.

List View, Standard Mode. This is the mode when first going to the main List View. This is what the buttons do in this mode:

Up, Down – Scrolls the list a screen at a time, just like the standard **Page Up** and **Page Down** buttons would do.

Left, Right – Goes to the *previous* or *next* saved view state. This is the same as tapping the **Back** or **Forward** buttons on the screen, when they are shown.

Select – Highlights the name at the top of the list and goes into **Select Mode**.

List View, Select Mode. After pressing **Select** in standard mode, this is what the buttons do:

Up, Down – Moves the highlight up or down one person at a time, scrolling as required when at the top or bottom of the list. Hold the button down for rapid scrolling.

Left – Cancels **Select Mode**, returns to **Standard Mode**.

Right – Takes you to the **Details View** for the currently highlighted person.

Select – Pressing this button takes you to the **Family View** for the currently highlighted person.

Family View, Standard Mode. This is the mode when entering this view for a person.
